A. CALL TO ORDER

District Manager Jason Pierman called the August 1, 2022, Regular Board Meeting of the Wyndam Park Community Development District (the "District") to order at 7:00 p.m. at the FAU/Pine Jog Environmental Education Center at 6301 Summit Boulevard, West Palm Beach, Florida 33415.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Mr. Pierman presented proof of publication that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in *The Palm Beach Post* on July 14, 2022, and July 21, 2022, as legally required.

C. CONSIDER RESIGNATION AND APPOINTMENT TO BOARD VACANCY
